Decorating Guidelines & Requirements

- Decorating begins at 10am and must conclude by 4pm December 7th
- You must provide all decorations for your tree. You are free to express your creativity and originality, but we ask that your tree represent your business, organization or family and be in good taste, suitable for display at a family event.
- Please use decorations that can withstand the wind and rain
- Be sure to check your lights to make sure they are working before putting them on the tree.
- Small plastic zip ties, pipe cleaners, string, or other ties should be used to secure your decorations. Do not use ornament hooks
- Please connect your tree lights to a #12-gauge heavy duty rated outdoor extension cord
- While you are decorating, please watch small children as they can trip and fall on cords, and wires, plus it is a busy street and we want to insure everyone's safety. Adults should exercise care, too!
- The Village DPW will check all trees periodically; however, it is recommended that you assign someone to check your tree, as well. Please remember that trees will be out in the elements for roughly 30 days and wind, rain, and other weather may cause ornaments to fall.
- The display will be monitored regularly by the Village Police. However, we cannot be responsible for any stolen or missing ornaments or decorations. Hopefully, this will not be a problem.
- Decorations and lights may be removed between January 2 and January 5, 2025. NOT BEFORE!
- Any decorations and lights that remain on trees as of January 6, 2025 will be considered left for donation and used for future Elves Day Out events.
